Question: "Who was Moses' wife? Did Moses have more than one wife?" Answer: The Bible does not say much about Moses' wife, Zipporah. We know that she was the daughter of a man called Jethro (or Reuel), who was a priest in the land of Midian (Exodus 3:1; cf. 2:18).

Zipporah or Tzipora (/ ' z ɪ p ə r ə , z ɪ ' k : r ə /; Hebrew: תִּצְפּוֹרָה, Tsippōrāh, "bird") is mentioned in the Book of Exodus as the wife of Moses, and the daughter of Reuel/Jethro, the priest or prince of Midian. In the Book of Chronicles, two of her descendants are mentioned: Shebuel, son of Gershom, and Rehabiah, son of Eliezer.
